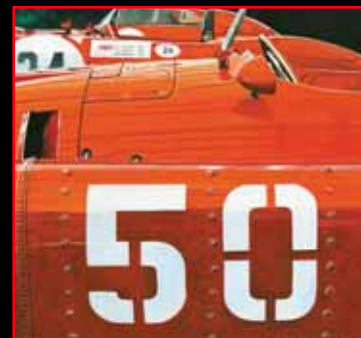


# SPEED DREAMS
